Guide for Accessing NCVPS Grade Reports and No-Show Reports

NCVPS posts grades reports and No-Show reports in the registration system. Follow these steps to retrieve your reports.

1. Log in to the NCVPS registration system at https://registration.ncvps.org

2. Click the Reports button in the registration system.



3. Click on the button next to the report that you want to download.

4. Click the "Mini Report" or "Full Report" to begin the download. The Mini Report will include all the grade information you need. The Full Report will include other student data (address, phone, etc.)

The report will open in an Excel spreadsheet. Grade information will be in the last columns of the spreadsheet. These fields will be on the report:

Progress Grade = All courses (except OCS and co-teaching) will have a numeric grade reported here.

Comment = All instructors will leave a comment.

Status = This field is used for credit recovery only.
